The Department has constantly intervened in the processes of review of internal flows and procedures by introducing new processes and management systems, especially in the areas of Logistics, Procurement and Partnership Management, mainly focusing on the processes of qualification, selection and management of the life cycle of Suppliers (Vendor Management) and Partners.

New management tools have been introduced including a supplier register (Vendor Database), an IT platform for facility management, a Business Intelligence tool for procurement and a Partnership Relationship Management System (PRMS).

The procedures related to the internal safety management processes have been reworked and the department has actively contributed to the definition of the flows related to the Organization Model (Legislative Decree 231/2001) and the ultimate Risk Assessment.

On the operational side, almost 30 million Euro per year of procurement processes for the purchase of goods and services have been put under control, about 100 Italian partners (charities, non-profit orgs, associations, cooperatives, social enterprises) have been selected or assessed and over new 50 operating facilities (25,000+ s.m.) in Italy have been requalified and opened, including the selection, design and procurement process for the new headquarters of about 5,000 square meters in Rome.

The hospital (350 local employees, 65 international doctors, nurses, health professionals and technicians) is the only free of charge, world-standard, health facility of its kind in an area 3 times bigger than Europe and with a population of about 300 million people between Sudan and the 9 neighboring countries (yearly budget of the project: about 10 million Euro). In Khartoum, I also dealt with the definition and rationalization of the logistics and supply chain process of the pharmacy, for which an inventory management software/database was created (including MRP and BI tools) for managing stock and reordering procedures, which led to a consistent optimization of the processes and reduction of the items, with a consequent reduction in both carrying and ordering costs (up to 30%). At the same time, a galenic laboratory project and related business plan were developed. During the last year in Sudan, I have also directly managed, from the contract phase to the construction phase, the construction of a housing complex of 2000+ square meters for our international staff capable of accommodating 70 people (Aga Khan Award for Architecture 2013).
